More than 10000 students to get ICDL certificates during summer training camps in the GCC

1,600 UAE national students to earn ICDL at Summer Camps held at UAE University and Abu Dhabi University

ICDL GCC Foundation, the governing body and certification authority of the International Computer Driving Licence (ICDL) program in the Gulf States, has recently announced that more than More than 10000 students are to get ICDL certificates during ICDL summer training camps in the GCC region, among them 1,600 students in the UAE enrolled in ICDL Summer Camps 2008 and will earn their ICDL certificates.
