## Sharjah TV endorses the ICDL digital literacy standard

The move aims to promote IT literacy among Sharjah TV staff

The agreement was signed by H.E. Khaled Ismail Safar, Managing Director of Sharjah TV, and Jamil Ezzo, Director General of ICDL GCC Foundation.

The implementation of the ICDL international standard within the Sharjah TV organization aims to increase the productivity of its staff and improve its services to its viewers and the general public. By meeting globally recognized standards, employees will be able to utilize all modern technologies available to enhance the quality and content of television programs offered by the channel, which will improve the media performance and strengthen the role of Sharjah TV in the media field locally and regionally.

We have full confidence in the supporting role of this agreement and believe that our move to establish an internationally recognized training centre will be well received by our employees, and it will help us in achieving our strategic plans to play a leading role in visual media in the Arab World," said H.E.
